As members of AAUW we are dedicated to promote the education of girls and women. Here is an excellent way to accomplish this goal. You will find the following projects very rewarding and your assistance, in any small way, will enhance the quality of these programs. Many hands make light work!

TECH TREK: We send three seventh grade girls to TECH TREK camp on the campus of the University of California, San Diego each year. The girls spend a week on campus living in the dorms and taking STEM classes on campus. This is an AAUW California State Project. Help is always welcome with such jobs as printing, sending and receiving applications, reading and ranking essays, interviewing girls, contacting parents, and planning a get together with parents and girls before and after they attend camp.

STEM CONFERENCE: (Previously aka Math/Science Conference) There are many jobs to be done here: Serving as facilitators to the speakers; serving as guides or monitors in the cafeteria; typing and printing the programs; checking in the speakers, guests, etc. on the day of the conference; contacting speakers; writing follow-up emails; printing applications; and distributing applications to schools etc. These are all small jobs that contribute to the success of a conference.

Tech Trek takes place in late June each year and work is begun on the project in March of each year. STEM (Math/Science Conference) takes place in early January and planning begins in late August.
